Christian Women's Job Corps & Tiftarea House of Hope

As we continue to follow the Lord in the ministry, we see His hand at work around us. We are so THANKFUL He has given us a house that we can make a Home for homeless women and children. A local church has offered us the use of their pastorium for this purpose. What a great and powerful God we serve. Speaking to a church about this ministry and their unanimous vote to move forward with this wonderful and selfless partnership is an example of "where God is working". We will be responsible for any improvements and changes that are needed and future maintenance and upkeep of the property.

Now that we have the house we are working on compliance issues and expect to have that resolved by the end of October and ready to move forward with those renovations. And of course God will do a compete work; he has provided us with an architect to prepare and submit our proposed use of the house, we have already had several people with teams to step up and volunteer their services to help us with the grounds work. We look forward to connecting with more volunteers to assist us in completion of the rest of the tasks and renovations. Our first job will be to raise the floor in what is presently a utility room to the existing house floor level and convert it to an office. We have 4 bedrooms and 3 bathrooms, large kitchen and dining space, with a great space for a kid's nook, large laundry area, pantry and a fenced in yard (the children will love this).

As part of our sustainable income we are planning to open a Thrift Store. When God provided the space, also donated by a local church we began the plan of how we could best use this space for His purpose and be obedient to what He was calling us to do. With the idea of a thrift store my first thought was "oh no not another thrift store". But we totally trust God with this and will move forward and follow where He leads. We are also working on this location and hope to have the conversion completed by the end of October. I'm sure by now you are asking how you might help, so for those of you that ask this question here are some needs.

- ♦ Carpentry work to construct the floor and walls for an office
- Carpentry work to increase some interior doors for handicap purposes
- Painting: we will be painting in both the house and the Thrift Store
- Renovate an existing bathroom to handicap accessible
- Furnish and equip the house for women and children

We look forward to seeing this ministry in operation, when we receive calls that a women and child needs shelter (we have received 3 such calls in the past 10 days) we will not have to put them in a motel somewhere while we work out a place we can move them to, but we will be able to house them, connect them to other services and ministries in town. We have transportation to get them to work, job readiness training and mentoring (Christian Women's Job Corp), parenting skills (Lifehouse Ministries), if we have a woman that is fleeing from a domestic situation (Ruth's Cottage) or dealing with a life situation in early pregnancy (Pregnancy Care Center) or a foster care issue (Called to Care). We will serve as a referral for those women who are dealing with substance abuse, not to turn them away but offer options to them.
