

JAKE'S DAY

As you may know the Mell Baptist Association has had a ministry at Jake's Day sponsored by the Department of Natural Resources. In the last few years it has been mainly a ministry of distributing water. The Mell Evangelism/Missions Team would like to make sure it includes an evangelistic emphasis. In fact, we will be evaluating all the association sponsored ministries to make sure that they have an evangelistic emphasis. We have already ordered bottled water that will have our logo and scriptures on the label.

We are, therefore, requesting that this become more focused on evangelism by our churches. We are proposing that we have four churches who would commit to have at least 5 persons to take an hour and a half time period (see below) to distribute water and engage people in intentional evangelistic conversations with those present at Jake's Day. These volunteers from your church could be high schoolers or older people, but with the ability to engage strangers in a meaningful conversation about their spiritual condition with the goal of leading them to respond to Christ as Savior. This could be an excellent mission effort by a youth group, SS class, Men's Ministry, Brotherhood, WMU, or other such group. We would hope that you would use this occasion to provide those in your church a training on how to share their faith (if you have not done it in a while). Let me know if you need assistance to do this.

MinistrySafeTM Skillful Screening Training

An effective screening process must address the risk of hiring an applicant whose motives are wrong. Criminal background checks alone will not protect children from sexual abuse. Statiscally, less than 10 percent of sexual offenders are ever criminally prosecuted, because two out of three children don't report abuse until years later, if ever. As a result, over 90 percent of offenders have no past criminal conviction to check.

To address this risk, every ministry should have a system of protection in place, as opposed a single screening or training element. MinistrySafeTM provides state of the art tools and training to help churches successfully screen future hires. Training is being offered at the following location.
