

## AM THOUGHTS

Acts 1:8 (KJV) says “But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.” What does that mean for you, your church, and the association? It is an important question for us to answer individually, as a church, and as an association because it will determine how and to whom we minister as Christians, as a church, and as an association. I would like to provide some thoughts about this verse.

First, it is a statement of fact that we are to be witnesses after the Holy Spirit has come upon us. We won’t be effective witnesses without the Holy Spirit controlling us. What does it mean to be a witness? A witness is someone who shares what he has seen, knows, or has experienced. That is exactly what God expects of us in sharing with others. The whole object of our “ministries” to the community (homeless, poor, any in need) is to share what we know about Jesus Christ and the Gospel. That is why the Mell Evangelism/Missions Team is working hard to make all the ministries sponsored by our association evangelistic as a part of that ministry whether it be the Food Pantry, Jakes’ Day, Downtown Holiday Christmas Celebration, mission trips, or area wide crusade. Whether it be backpacks for Appalachia or weekend food bags for food deficient children here or in Decatur, Georgia, the purpose should be to share the truth of the Gospel! That is why I, as a senior adult, went on a mission trip to Decatur, Georgia, and to the Olympics in South Korea, participated in Jake’s Day ministry, and the Downtown Holiday Christmas Celebration ministry. I want to be a witness for the Lord here and abroad!

Second, this statement of fact to be witnesses has a local/global emphasis. It is not just local (our Jerusalem) or global (the uttermost part of the world). The emphasis must be on our Jerusalem (local), Judea (example: Georgia), Samaria (example: outcasts of society), and the uttermost (global) all at the same time. We will not have been accomplishing this if we only do one of these at a time or concentrate on only one! My prayer and dream for every church and our association is that we will have mission teams and/or individuals being witnesses in our town/area, the state of Georgia, somewhere else in North America, and internationally. Our Evangelism/Missions Team has goals for us to sponsor mission teams to somewhere in Georgia, somewhere in North America other than Georgia, and overseas. We will not see this come to pass unless we take seriously the truth of Acts 1:8. We must keep looking for ways that we can be witnesses here locally as well as outside our area and around the world.

I pray and hope that you will want to be a part of what God will lead us as churches and as an association to do to do Acts 1:8 as well as obey the Great Commission (Matthew 28:19-20).

I hope that if you are a teacher/leader in your church’s Sunday School that you will take advantage of the Sunday School Leader Training that the association has planned for Saturday, September 8, at FBC Tifton. We start with registration at 8:30 AM and conclude at noon. There will be breakout sessions for Pastors/Directors, Adults, Youth, Children, and Preschool. ## BCM NEWS

I do have one student, in particular, I want you to pray for. This young lady has had a hard life and her Christian walk has faltered due to guys and friends. Well, she has come back this semester bound and determined to walk closely with Christ. Her whole demeanor seems changed. Please pray that she will continue to seek God diligently and not get distracted. Please pray she will stay in the Word and grow more in her love for God. Right now she is seeking some godly friends who will hold her accountable and challenge her to grow. Please pray she will find them and not revert back to her old ways.

Pray for us as we continue to seek God's wisdom in finding ways to reach out to the students on this campus. I appreciate you folks and the churches in our association. If I could, I would love to come to your church on a Sunday night or Wednesday and thank your people. I would only take a few minutes, because we would not be here without you and you are appreciated!
