AM THOUGHTS

Martha and I attended the annual GBMB Associational Missionaries Workshop at Toccoa February 4-6. It is always good to see and fellowship with other AMs and their wives. Some, we don't see but a couple of times a year! Our featured speaker was Josh Ellis, Executive Director, of the Union Baptist Association in Houston, Texas. He challenged us to relook at associations and the future of associations. One of the takeaways for me was—the theme for associations, Better Together. What a great theme for us! We are Better Together! The second takeaway was that we need to move from recruitment to development in terms of future leaders. Associational churches need to work Better Together in developing future pastors, other workers in our churches, as well as in the association. I was particularly struck with the thought that we as associational churches need to work together to develop (call out the called) to be bi-vocational pastors. We are facing a crisis in having a pool of bi-vocational pastors! What if churches in the association would begin calling out the called, training/developing them to be bi-vocational pastors, part-time youth ministers, and/or part-time music directors? Please pray with me about what we can do Better Together to meet this crisis!

We concluded our THRIVE Roundtables. I want to thank Randy Mullinax, State Missionary, GBMB, for leading our roundtables and for those who participated. We concluded with seven different churches being represented. May God use the ideas presented and discussed to revitalize those churches!

By now I hope that you have heard that we will be having an evangelistic crusade here in Tifton in partnership with the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association in March of 2020 with Will Graham (grandson of Billy Graham) being the evangelist. The exact date has not been determined yet. On Thursday, March 19, at 7 PM at the Leroy Rogers Senior Center a BGEA Representative will be making a presentation on what will need to happen here for us to be able to have this Will Graham Celebration. Light refreshments will be served. A Steering Committee will be named that night to begin the process of organizing for this endeavor. I hope that your pastor and a few key leaders will be present for this important meeting. Letters have been mailed to churches within a 30-mile radius of Tifton inviting them to this meeting. Would you begin praying now for all the preparation that will need to take place as well as Will Graham? Pastors and staff are invited to an Areawide Monthly Prayer Meeting for the Will Graham Celebration. Our next Prayer Time will be Thursday, February 28 at 7 AM at the Mell Office. The March Prayer Time will be March 28 at 7 AM. We had 14 at the first Prayer Time on January 31. I strongly believe that this event is coming in God's divine timing to make a difference in the Tifton area. Let's get on board and see what God will do as we work Better Together!

Because of becoming a member of the Alliance Defending Freedom Church Alliance, this organization reviewed our Constitution & By-Laws as well as our Manual of Policies & Procedures. They suggested needed changes concerning our Statement of Faith, statement on sexuality, and statement on human life to both documents. Your Administrative Team has already approved the additions to the M of P&P. At our February 28 Mell Executive Committee Meeting at 7 PM at the Mell Office the changes to the Mell Constitution & By-Laws will be presented in writing according to the procedure of the present document. These changes will be discussed at the June 27 Executive Committee meeting and voted on at the Annual Meeting October 20
