AM THOUGHTS

I was ordained into the Gospel Ministry by Glendale Baptist Church, Hattiesburg, Mississippi, on June 15, 1969; thus, I have now been in active ministry for over 50 years. Martha and I had attended this loving church while in college at then William Carey College, Hattiesburg. As I reflect over 50 years of ministry, I have seen lots of changes, but one constant has been the faithfulness of God--He has been so faithful in His dealings with Martha and me. I would like to share some of what God in His faithfulness has permitted us to do over these fifty years. Please indulge me this one time! While at New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary, I was the pastor of the Charity Hospital Mission sponsored by Central Baptist Church. After graduation God led us to Montana where I pastored East Helena Baptist Mission (sponsored by Calvary Baptist Church, Helena) and Helena Valley Baptist Church. While pastoring Helena Valley I was the Chaplain for Mountain View School for Girls (a correction facility of the State of Montana). I had the privilege of being the Chairman of the Executive Committee of the Ralph Bell Evangelistic Crusade (sponsored by the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association) in 1978. Some of the other responsibilities that God permitted me to be a part of: Secretary and later President: Helena Evangelical Ministers' Fellowship

Director: Children's Camp, Treasure State Baptist Association, Montana Secretary: Montana Southern Baptist Fellowship

Business Manager: Montana Southern Baptist Assembly

In 1980 God led us to return south where I became the Interim Pastor and Pastor of Temple Baptist Church, Adamsville, Alabama. It was there that God showed us His faithfulness again and led us to make application to the then Foreign Mission Board. We were appointed as missionaries December 7, 1982 and we arrived in Israel on April 27, 1983. We went to work with Jewish people. God permitted us to begin a Hebrew speaking congregation in the Upper Area of Nazareth. In our third term there I was asked to become the first full-time Administrator of the Baptist Convention in Israel (the mission group there). In this position I worked with all the FMB personnel there as well as Jewish Messianic congregations, Arab Baptist Congregations, and other evangelical groups. I was also the Secretary and later Chairman of the United Christian Council in Israel (Fellowship of Evangelicals).

In June of 1997 we came back to the U. S. not knowing what God had in store for us but sensed His direction to pursue working with an association. I answered an ad in the Alabama Baptist paper for the position of Director of Missions in Mallary Baptist Association, Albany, Georgia. The rest of the story, I retired from there in December of 2015. God showed his faithfulness there as we saw God mold the association into an active evangelistic and mission-oriented group of churches. I had the privilege of serving as First Vice President of the Georgia Baptist Convention and President of the Georgia Associational Missionaries Fellowship. We participated in mission trips to Idaho, New York, France, Moldova, England, and Mexico (numerous times). I also was a part of the Executive Committee of the Southwest Georgia Celebration with Ralph Bell in Albany (sponsored by the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association) in 2001.

God opened another door for Him to show His faithfulness in April of 2016 for me to become the Interim and the next year the full-time Associational Missionary for the Mell Baptist Association, Tifton. Thank you for letting me serve the Lord through this association!

All this to show how God will lead you when you are willing to follow Him without reservation. I could not imagine as a young man, that, after 50 years of ministry, God would have let me be involved in so many areas of Christian ministry. He receives all the honor and glory! Anything good that was done was His doing, not ours! Thank you for letting me share God's faithfulness to Martha and me with you!

BCM News

The Bible tells us to share the gospel and I experienced this past month the true impact of sharing. I had the opportunity to lead a BCM team at Camp Chula. While there I taught a 4th grade class of 31 children. Two days I shared with them unique ways to share the plan of salvation. The first day I challenged them, the kids shared the gospel with 70 people and the second day they shared with 95 people for a total of 165. Think of this, a class of 31 had 165 sharing contacts. How awesome is that? Through this experience, God gave me a renewed vision to push my students to share the gospel without hesitation this next semester. Small children do not get so upset about what others think and just do what God asks. Please pray that BCM students and I will see the lost as God does and develop a deeper heart of compassion for them. Pray that they will care more about reaching the lost than what people think. What about you? Do you share the gospel without hesitation? How different would ABAC and Tift county be if we saw the lost as Christ did and shared with the zeal of Paul? Think of the impact this would have on the crusade we are planning in the spring! I am praying for this!

The semester will begin soon, and we are going crazy planning. Please pray that the new students will find a group of Christian friends quickly. The pull to slip away from church and put Jesus on the back burner is strong those first few days. Before the first day is over 95% will be asked to go to a party or the local bar. We are doing all we can to make connections those first few days. These are long hot days and during the middle of things my son is getting married. Those first two weeks will be wild so please pray for us to have strength and the heart of Christ for the incoming students. The student leaders are getting so excited. Thanks for your prayers!
