#### **AM Thoughts**

WOW! What a great mission trip to Ichmul, Mexico. We went through an organization called Misison House International which has a mission house (a place for teams to stay). Despite power outages which meant no air conditioning and water (especially hot water) plus a lot of rain, God worked through our Mell Mission Team to accomplish His purpose. There were 13 of us from Brookfield Baptist Church (3) and CrossView Baptist Church (9). Steve Davis, pastor of Brookfield Baptist Church, was going, but was exposed to Covid a couple of days before leaving, but it was providential that he remain to minister after the death of the 3 year old girl in his church. I am always amazed and thankful for the team that God puts together! This was a fantastic team—cooperative, flexible, and talented! To God be the glory!

For the first time we had a medical team made up of a physician's assistant, nurse, and an emergency medical person. They did physicals for children in three grades in one school. On the day I helped them, they saw 19 teenagers. They did home health visits almost every day. Overall they saw approximately 60 patients in four days meeting the physical needs, but ministering spiritually. The nurse was able for the first time to share a Gospel presentation to one lady and that lady accepted Christ as her Savior. PTL!

We had different teams to do ESL in three classes in two schools. What a great way to encourage these students to understand and speak more English as well as our team having a positive Christian influence upon them.

Vacation Bible School was held Sunday-Wednesday with a high of 75 children plus some mothers. All of us helped out in one form or another, but our ladies including two teachers did a fantastic job of preparing the lessons, a craft, and games. Our teenagers were a great help with VBS. In fact, even on Thursday, when we had not planned to have VBS about a dozen kids showed up! Our team adapted and provided games for them. This number of children was the largest that the church in Ichmul had had in 5 or 6 years! To God be the glory!

Greg Love, pastor of CrossView, and I led 7-10 (depending on the day) leaders or potential leaders there in going through Experiencing God. We took copies of the Experiencing God workbook in Spanish for them to use. It was obvious that this study was timely for them. Some were discouraged and needed to understand that God was at work all the time and they needed to join him. In fact, after the second day, the pastor of the Ichmul church (also the director of Mission House) told me he was going to preach on the six steps in the process of Experiencing God! It was obvious that this study had a great impact on those who attended. We also provided them the videos and other materials in Spanish for them to use to go through it as it was designed. We only did an overview for them. Just to let you know, that your giving to the association provided the above materials for these pastors and leaders in Ichmul. Please pray that they will be faithful to go through the study and then lead others through this study.

Just a few days before the trip, we learned that Eli and a pastor in Peto wanted Greg and me to do a two day conference for pastors and leaders in Peto. The first day Greg did an overview of Experiencing God and the second day Greg and I did a dialogue on the five purposes of the church (worship, ministry, discipleship, evangelism, and equipping) based on the Great Commandment and the Great Commission. Although the attendance was not what was expected, we tried to be faithful to do what God wanted us to do. Please pray for the pastors to get a vision for ministry outside the walls of the church and for unity of the churches in Peto.

This is just part of our Acts 1:8 strategy to be witnesses in our Jerusalem (local), Judea (Georgia), Samaria (North America), and to the uttermost (for us Mexico). Thank you for your support through prayer and your giving to the association. You are making a difference in people's lives!

As you will see in Penny's article on the back, we have a new BCM Director, but she will not be able to start until January and her name cannot be released yet. We are praising God that Penny is willing to fill in until the new person can come onboard as well as praising God that we have a new person for this ministry! Praise Him!

Ya'll, I am like a South Georgia gnat! You just can't get rid of me. I retired on May 11<sup>th</sup> and was called back and asked to serve till January. There is someone in mind to take over but they can't be here till next semester -so you have to put up with me a little while longer! We have been busy cleaning out stuff from the building, Can you imagine what has been collected over all these years! We have also been busy getting ready for the fall. Please pray for our summer group as we prepare welcome bags, Bible studies, and outreach avenues for the fall. It is getting exciting as we prepare, but still have a long way to go to be ready. We have some great volunteers from the community who are helping and it has been a blessing!

We have 14 serving this summer and they need your prayers. I have talked with most of them and working in kids camp in the heat has been a struggle. Please pray y for them to have wisdom and stamina to continue the rest of the summer. I have been able to visit with several when they worked in the area, and it has been interesting to see how God has used them. One is working in the Bronx of New York and desperately needs prayer for safety. I had the privilege of seeing some students work with kids in camp and it was a blessing to see our big football player leading a group of first graders - it was very evident to see how God was using this experience to create in him a shepherd's heart. Each week many are seeing souls come to Christ and it is changing them. Please pray that God will continue to fan the flame of this hunger to see people saved and will bring it back to campus! Your prayers have made a difference - I asked you to pray for our new Christians and some of them have returned home for the summer and they are trying to reach their family and friends with the gospel. Please continue to pray because friends and family are much harder to reach than strangers! Some of them are fighting overcoming their past when they reach out people have a hard time accepting they have changed. One commented that she is seeing some headway with one of her siblings. They need prayer to not lose heart and give up!

This summer has been a small group, but God is truly working. Three of the guys are involved in a cohort that is together and on trips a lot this summer. Last week we talked about how to reach their classmates and how to have gospel conversations. They really love their classmates and desire to see them touched by the Lord. Please pray for them to have wisdom and eyes to see when God provides opportunities. Also, pray for hearts to be softened. It was amazing to look at their faces and see them realize that if their friends do not accept Christ, they will spend eternity in hell. It was as if you could just see God putting a fire in their hearts to reach out. They began to realize that if they don't reach out - who will? One of the young men is starting a small Bible study with some friends so please pray for him as he seeks to teach the truth to them.

This past month an International Student lived with my family as she waited to go to New Hampshire to teach in a tennis camp. It was strange how this came about – I really did not know her well at all, but she needed a place to stay so she came to our home. One night when we were talking, I asked her why she thought she was living with us and involved in BCM and Bible school this month. She, came to the conclusion, that God wanted to remind her that she is a light in the darkness on campus and her mission field is her teammates. She hopes to reach out more to them in the fall. Please pray for her that she will find favor with her team and her coaches. Pray that God will provide her opportunities to serve her team and earn the right to be heard and that hearts will be receptive to the gospel.
