AM Thoughts

Well, GLORY!!!! Praise the Lord! Anyway you look at it, the Mell Tent Revival was a success! It has come and gone. We have been planning this event since December of last year. Ashley Roig, Chairman of the Evangelism/Missions Team and pastor of Salem BC, shared his desire to see a tent revival in Tifton. The Team wholeheartedly endorsed the concept and began planning. The Evangelism/Missions Team asked the Encouraging/Strengthening Team to meet with them since prayer and training would be necessary for a successful event. The two teams began meeting in January of this year and met monthly until the present. The date of September 19-21, 2025 was chosen. Thanks to Glenn Ford, Van Lindsey, and Ashley Roig (chairman Evan/Mis) and Brad Baker and Jason Loggins (chairman of Encr/Strng) for their hard work planning this event. I am a member of both teams.

The Teams selected Stacy Phillips (pastor of Northside BC), John Smith (pastor of FBC Ty Ty), and Tim Williams (evangelist) to preach Friday, Saturday, and Sunday nights respectively. Steve Davis (pastor of Brookfield BC) was asked to lead the music. We began to work on the different groups of volunteers that we would need—Counselors, Greeters, Parking, Security, and Ushers. The date of August 16 was selected to do training for evangelism and counseling. The Encr/Strng Team had already decided to have an evangelism training in 2025, and Steve Foster (GBMB Evangelism) was asked to lead this training. There were 47 present from 12 churches at Calvary BC and 31 committed to counsel. It was also decided to have a combined choir practice on September 9 at Brookfield BC with 62 from 14 churches present. The volunteer training was held at Eastside BC with 43 present from about 12 churches.

The total amount of contributions for the Tent Revival was \$44,525 from 16 churches (Alapaha, Brookfield, Brushy Creek, Calvary, Eastside, Enigma, FBC Chula, FBC Tifton, FBC Ty Ty, Lakeview, Lenox, Mt. Zion, Northside, Salem, The Road, Zion Hope) and 11 businesses or organizations (Central Jewelry, Curtis Packing Company, Georgia Baptist Mission Board, Howard Center, Intrepid Building Systems, Southeastern Carts, Structure by Chris Brooks, Tifton Peanut Company, Veazey White CPAs & Business Advisors). Again, praise the Lord! Expenses that we know of so far are \$43,993.82 which includes one expense for which we have not received an invoice. The total amount of the Love Offering for the three nights was \$7,439.60. This will be divided and love offerings given to the three preachers, the music leader, musicians, and one other who helped us from the fairgrounds. To God be the glory for the generosity of God's people!

The attendance at the Tent Revival increased each night from almost 700 on Friday night to almost 900 on Sunday night. The choir the first night had 81 and kept almost that number throughout the other nights. Steve Davis did an excellent job leading the music. The music was uplifting and led us to worship. The three testimonies were powerful and the prayer team was faithful to pray each night. The preaching was excellent! Stacy, John, and Tim presented the Gospel plainly and with power and the anointing of God's Holy Spirit. There were a number of people at the altar each of the nights, especially Sunday night. Our counselors counselled three Friday night with one profession of faith, Saturday night there were eleven counseled with four professions of faith. A total of 13 professions of faith for the three nights! Praise the Lord and to God be the glory!


