We praise the Lord for the ministry that the Mell Baptist Association had at the Santa's Helpers/Toys for Tots Toy Distribution on December 19 at the American Legion Fairgrounds. This is a drive-thru event. The Mell Association purchased 330 boxes of food and frozen ham logs from Second Harvest. We were able to give away 312 boxes of food and hams. As those in their cars come to our location at the fairgrounds, we place a box of food and ham in each car, give the people in the car a Christmas Gospel Tract, and have prayer with those in the car. We had eighteen volunteers from eight of our Mell churches (Brookfield, Calvary, Eastside, Enigma, First Baptist Tifton, First Baptist Ty Ty, Pine Grove, and Salem) and one non Mell church. Your church's contributions to the Mell Baptist Association make it possible for us to purchase food for this ministry. Thank you to all the volunteers and the generosity of our churches.

The Mell Ramp Builders built a 14-foot ramp for a lady that uses a walker and wheelchair on January 10. There were eleven men who showed up from two of our churches (Brookfield and Salem). We were finished in two hours! PTL! Again your church's contributions make it possible for us to purchase the material for the ramps. Thank you! The Ramp Builders hope to build one ramp per month in 2026.

Great news! As you know Mell Baptist Association is all about evangelism and missions (see above). The Encouraging/Strengthening decided that their emphasis for 2026 would be missions. To that end it was decided to plan a missions fair/banquet to highlight missions, especially local missions. See the front of the newsletter for information about the Mell Missions Fair/Banquet. It will be Thursday, March 5 (during the Week of Prayer for North American Missions), from 6-8 pm at Victory Baptist Church. A meal will be provided, but reservations are required. We will have displays and representatives from the Mell ministries as well as many of the local ministries that need volunteers. We will have a special guest to speak for us: Major Daniel Garnett, Chaplain, U. S. Army, who is an appointed chaplain of the North American Mission Board. We want all of our church people to attend and see the many opportunities we have locally to be on mission with God. Make your plans now to attend.

I am grateful to be your Associational Missionary. On April one I will have been serving you as Interim or full-time Associational Missionary for ten years (one year as interim and 9 as full-time). Thank you for the privilege you have given me to serve the Lord through the association and to serve you. For anything good that has happened give God the glory!



BAPTIST COLLEGIATE MINISTRY

Happy 2026, Mell Baptist Association! I pray your holidays was restful and focused on Christ. Our ABAC students returned for the spring 2026 semester on Tuesday, January 13 and are already deep into their classes and extracurriculars.

Our Christmas Mission Trip that took place just following finals at ABAC was our largest attended on record! We had 37 students stay in Tifton for a few days before their Christmas holiday to serve at Toys for Tots, help with some ministry needs in surrounding counties at Called to Care, Inc., and minister to some local individuals and families who needed help in their yards at their homes. Our mission team also went caroling two nights with Inaha Baptist Church in and around Turner County.

We have more mission opportunities coming up this spring with our Spring Break Mission Trip in March and One Day Fun Day, a foster care ministry event in April. And our students are good at finding other 1-day service opportunities too, so we will be adding to that list as the weather warms up for outdoor events.

The ABAC BCM continues to meet Monday nights and Thursday nights. Mondays we meet at 6pm with a meal followed by worship and a message. Thursday nights we meet at 6:30p with guy/girl Bible Study (guys meet in the back of the building and girls meet in the front of the building). We have some meal needs on Monday nights. If you are able to help us feed this college kids on one of the Monday nights listed below as "BCM" please send me a text or give me a call. The number of people fluctuates each week, but we plan for anywhere between 80 to 120 college students weekly. (However, that number is significantly lower late in the spring semester, as things wind down for the summer.)

We are grateful for our Mell Baptist churches. Thank you for helping us to reach the campus of ABAC: faculty, staff and students!
